



Notice and Opportunity to Comment

FM 3362 & FM 2061 (JACKSON RD.)

From SH 495 to Hall Acres Rd.

Main CSJ: 3468-01-021 and 1939-02-036

Hidalgo County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to widen FM 3362 and FM 2061 (Jackson Rd.) from SH 495 to Hall Acres Rd. in Hidalgo County, Texas. This notice is affording an opportunity to comment as part of the environmental review process for this project. If you are a property owner, you are receiving this notice because records indicate that you own property that (1) would be acquired (in part or in whole) for this project, or (2) is adjacent to the project. This notice and opportunity to comment is also being provided to affected local governments and public officials.

FM 3362 and FM 2061 (Jackson Rd.) between SH 495 and Hall Acres Rd. is experiencing reduced safety and operational efficiencies. TxDOT is proposing to widen FM 3362 and FM 2061 (Jackson Rd.) in Hidalgo County, a length of approximately 3.5 miles to three lanes in each direction with a raised median, provide dedicated turn lanes, construct pedestrian and bicycle paths, and improve intersections.

In March 2024, a virtual public meeting with an in-person option was held to present the proposed project to expand FM 3362 and FM 2061 (Jackson Road) from SH 495 to Hall Acres Road into a six-lane roadway. Following that meeting, TxDOT's review of future needs resulted in moving forward with a wider design. TxDOT is now proposing to include targeted intersection improvements along FM 3362 and FM 2061 to address increasing traffic volumes and enhance safety. At the intersection of E. Laurel Avenue and W. Warren Street, a dual left-turn lane island is proposed. This design provides two separate lanes for vehicles turning left, helping more drivers turn at the same time reducing wait times and increasing safety. At Jackson Road and Kelly Avenue, a continuous green "T" intersection is proposed. This type of intersection allows vehicles in the southbound direction to keep moving through without stopping, while Kelly Avenue traffic waits for a safe opening or signal. These improvements are expected to make travel more efficient, reduce delays, and improve safety for all travelers.

Subject to final design considerations, the proposed widening project would require additional right of way and potentially displace one residence and one non-residential structure. Relocation assistance is available for displaced persons and businesses. Information about the TxDOT Relocation Assistance Program and services and benefits for those displaced and other affected property owners, as well as information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction, can be obtained from the TxDOT Pharr District Office by calling Ramon Jimenez, Jr., ROW Supervisor, at (956) 702-6287.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Pharr District Office, 600 W. Interstate 2, Pharr, TX 78577, or by

calling (956) 702-6100. Project materials are also available online at www.txdot.gov, keyword search “Jackson Road Project – SH 495 to Hall Acres Road.”

The project materials are written in English. Individuals who need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, a translator/interpreter will be provided. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
