### Finding of No Significant Impact Available for Public Review

This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed FM 676 and Mile 5, and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project would widen FM 676 (Mile 5) from SH 107 (Conway Avenue) to FM 2220 (Ware Road) in Hidalgo County, Texas.

The FONSI and approved final environmental assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the Pharr District office, 600 W. Interstate 2 Pharr, TX 78577, at (956) 702-6100.
