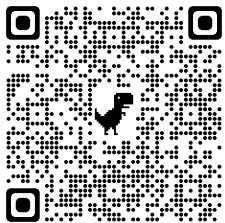

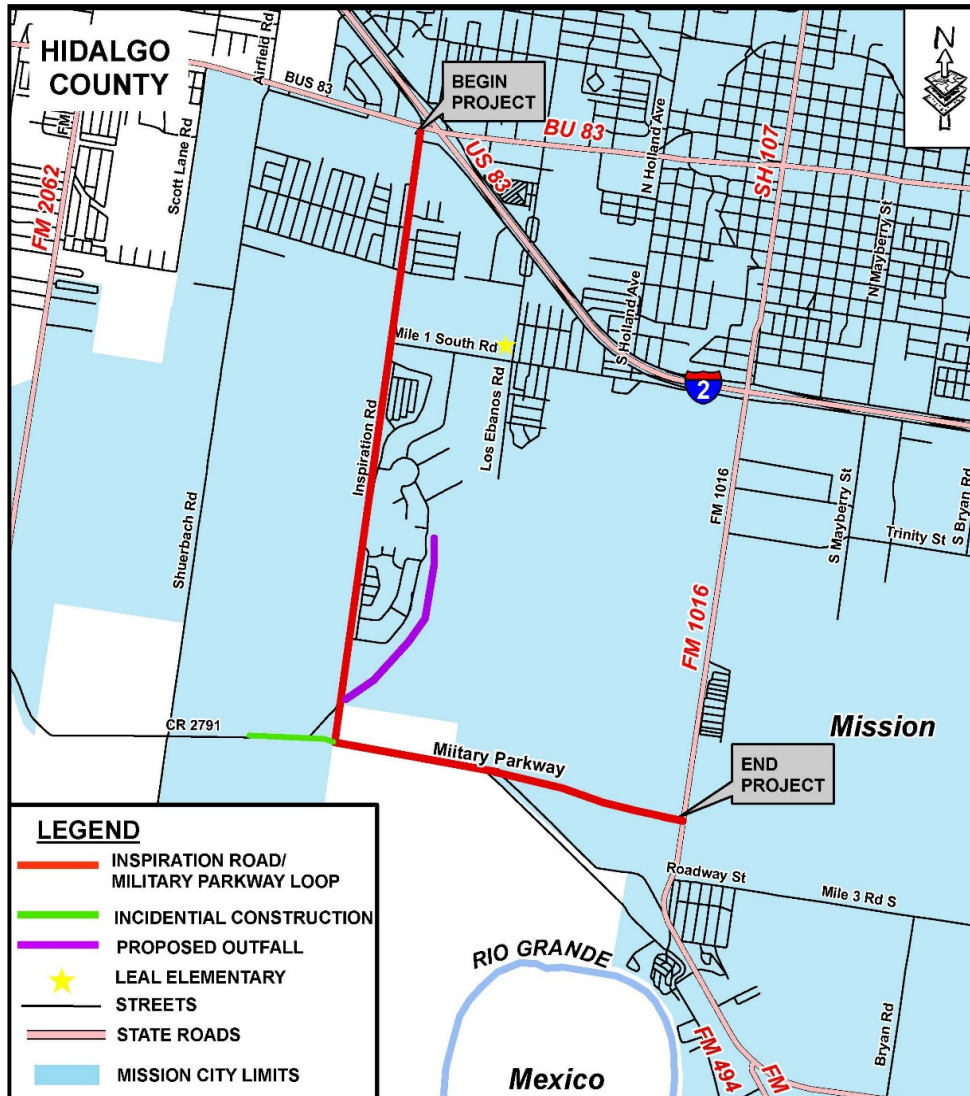

PROJECT NEED AND PURPOSE



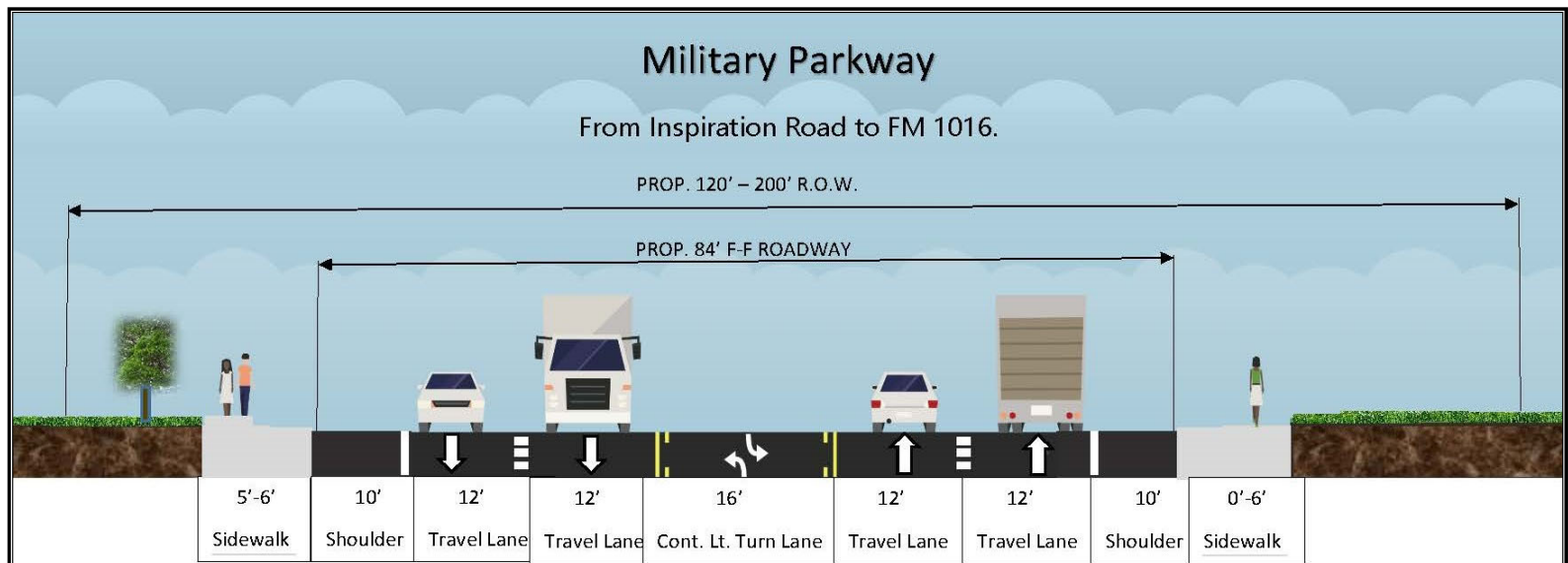
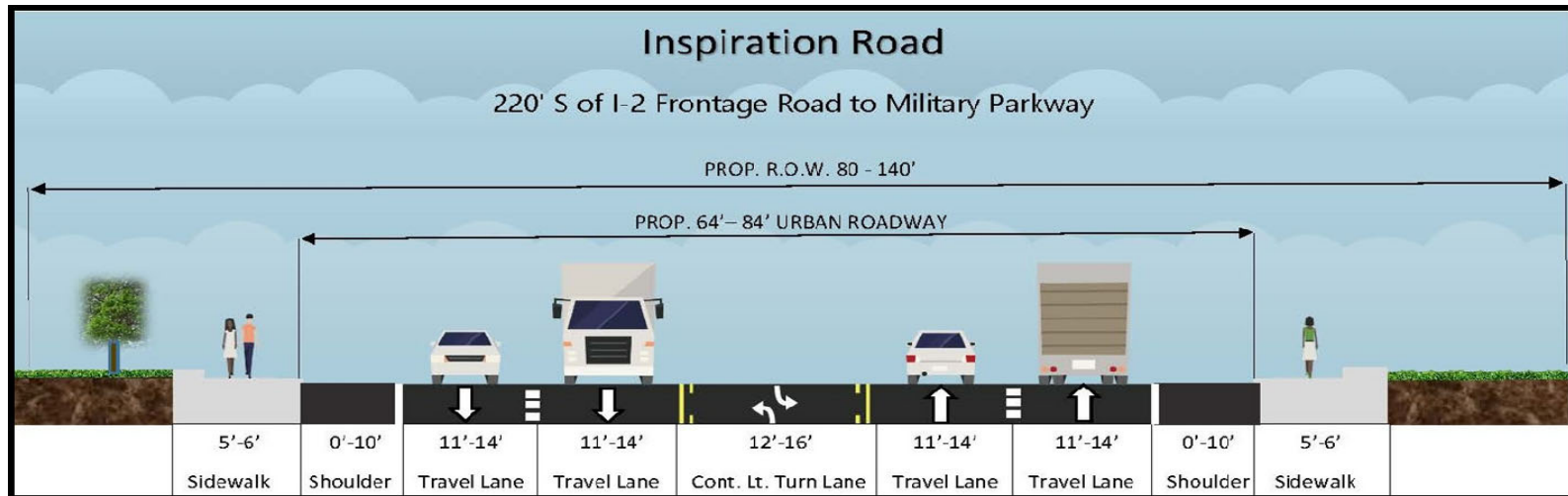
- **Project Need**

National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Compliance

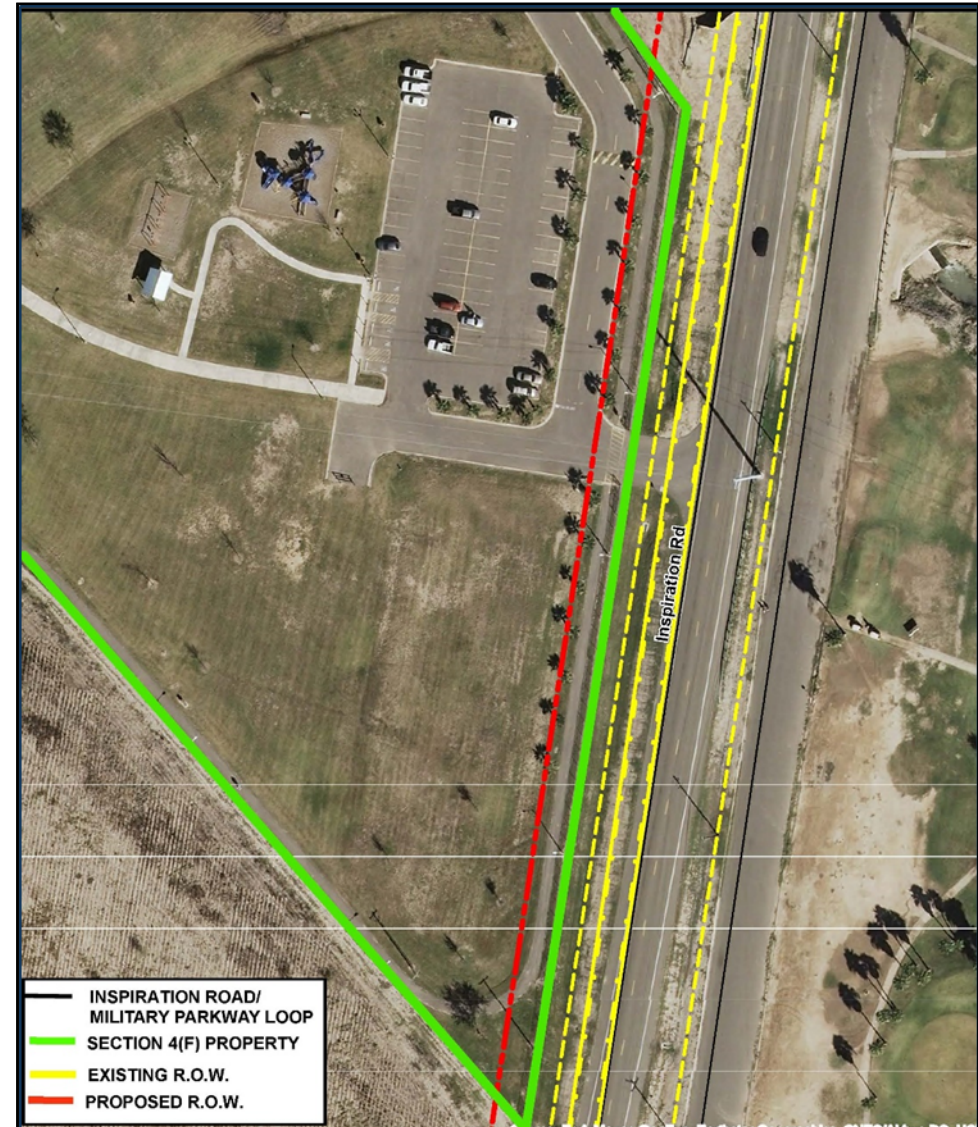
Memorandum of Understanding: The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 9, 2019, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.

What does this mean?: TxDOT is following all applicable state and federal laws to identify and review the potential solutions for long-term safety and mobility problems along Inspiration Road/Military Parkway Loop

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS

Bentsen Palm Community Park

- The project would require approx. 0.4 acres of ROW from the park, 14 palm trees would be relocated and 0.45 miles of the walking trail would be removed and replaced.
- No recreational structures associated with the park would be impacted.
- The palm trees would be relocated within the park and the walking trail would be replaced with sidewalks.
- A *de minimis* determination for this use under Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966 is anticipated.



ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS

Mission Hike and Bike Trail

- The proposed project would require the realignment of an approximate ½ mile section of the trail.
- No recreational structures associated with the hike and bike trail would be impacted.
- A *de minimis* determination for this use under Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966 is anticipated.

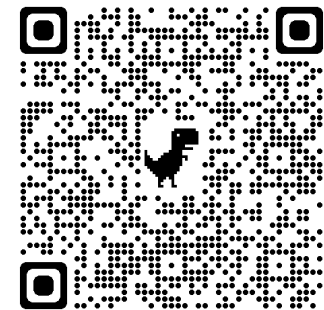
