**Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option**  
**SH 4 Boca Chica Boulevard**  
**From SH 48 to FM 313**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to improve SH 4 Boca Chica Boulevard from SH 48 to FM 313 in Cameron County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person option. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by 8 a.m. CST on Thursday, Sept. 23, 2021.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address ([www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov)) at the date and time indicated above and type "SH4 Public Meeting" into the search box at the top right corner of the webpage. Project staff will give a presentation which will be a pre-recorded video and will include both audio and visual components. Please note that the presentation will not be available on the website until the time and date listed above. Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above until Friday, Oct. 8, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. If you do not have internet access, you may call Samantha Lozano, P.E. at (956) 702-6334 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting which will be playing on screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants from a socially distanced approach, and leave written comments. **The in-person option will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. CST on Thursday, Sept. 23, 2021 at the TxDOT Brownsville Maintenance Facility at 1375 Military Hwy., Brownsville, TX 78523.**

The proposed improvements of SH 4 from SH 48 to FM 313 in Brownsville, Cameron County, Texas are designed to improve safety and mobility by utilizing a concrete raised median to separate traffic and consolidate left-turn movements. The project also proposes to include continuous sidewalks in the project area. The project is about 2.2 miles long.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project will be available online on Thursday, Sept. 23, 2021 at 8 a.m. at [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov) by typing the keyword "SH4 Public Meeting" in the search box. These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person option.

Both the virtual and in-person public meeting will be conducted in English and Spanish. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English or Spanish are not your primary languages or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English or Spanish, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
