Location and Length

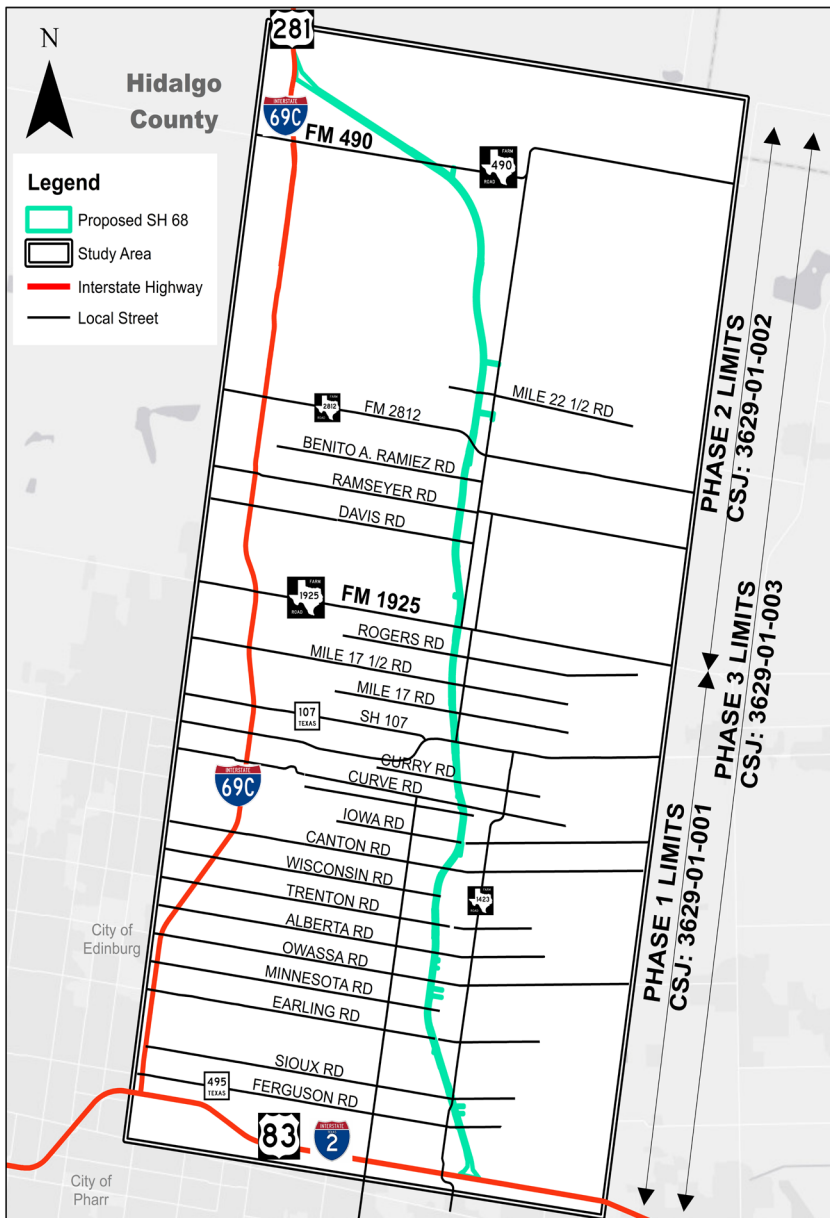
From I-2/US 83 to I-69C/US 281, in Hidalgo County, Texas. Approximately 22 miles.

Project's Need

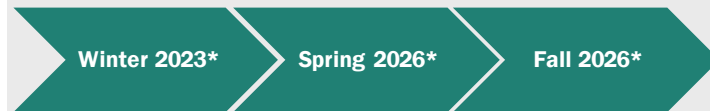
- provide an additional north/south route in Hidalgo County
- improve the emergency evacuation capacity of the state highway system

Project's Purpose

- accommodate population growth and higher traffic volumes
- relieve the burden on the limited number of existing north-south roadways
- provide an alternate north-south evacuation route during emergency events

- Right-of-way purchase complete
- Construction of Phase I
