The Texas Department of Transportation is holding a **virtual public meeting with an in-person option** to consider improving safety and mobility at the intersection of SH 16 and the Kansas City Southern (KCS) rail crossing in Jim Hogg County, TX.

The virtual public meeting will be available online beginning noon on Tuesday, Nov. 9, 2021. You may access the virtual meeting at www.txdot.gov, **keyword search "SH 16 at Railroad Grade Crossing."** The virtual public meeting and in-person option will be conducted in English and Spanish.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants from a socially distanced approach and leave written comments. The in-person option will be held on **Wednesday Nov. 10, 2021, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the Jim Hogg County Courthouse, 102 E. Tilley Street, Hebbronville, TX 78361.**
