



NOTICE OF VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING WITH IN-PERSON OPTION RURAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

TxDOT – San Antonio District will conduct an online virtual public meeting with an in-person option for the 2023 – 2026 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP). The purpose of this meeting is to provide information and receive comments on which transportation projects may be coming to your area. The San Antonio District encompasses the following counties: Atascosa, Bandera, Frio, Kendall, Kerr, McMullen, Medina, Wilson, and Uvalde. The Alamo Regional Rural Organization (ARRPO) also include Karnes and Gillespie County. The Rural TIP includes all added capacity and regionally significant projects to be funded within a TxDOT District during the next four years, including those eligible for federal funding.

You have two options to participate in the meeting and learn more about projects in the San Antonio District and ARRPO. Both options will present the same information:
