Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Open House Option

From Rodeo Way to FM 78

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to expand FM 1103 from Rodeo Way to FM 78 in Guadalupe County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting with an in-person open house option on the proposed project. The virtual public meeting will be posted online on **Thursday, June 23, 2022, at 5 PM**. To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: www.txdot.gov, keyword search "FM 1103 from Rodeo Way". Following the virtual public meeting, informational materials and presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above. If you do not have internet access, you may call Celeste Quinones at (210) 785-0888 between the hours of 8 AM to 5 PM Monday thru Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during project development process. Formal comments may be submitted by mail or email as explained below.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person open house option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same materials presented in the online public meeting, review project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and leave written comments. The in-person option will be held on **Thursday, June 23, 2022 from 5 to 7 PM at Noble Group Event Center, 203 S. Main St, Cibolo, Texas 78108** and will follow an "open house" format.

The proposed FM 1103 roadway would consist of four 11-foot lanes (two in each direction), with an additional continuous two-way left turn lane or raised center median, curbs, and shared-use paths for pedestrian and bicycle accommodation. Turning lanes would be provided at intersections. The proposed project would include drainage improvements. The proposed right-of-way (ROW) width to accommodate the improvements varies from 120-135 feet. The proposed project would involve construction in wetlands and would involve an action in the floodplains.

Although additional right-of-way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information about the tentative schedule for ROW acquisition and construction, can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling (210) 615-5886.

The virtual public meeting and in-person open house option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided for you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting or in-person open house option, please contact **Celeste Quinones, at cquinones@rjrivera.com or call (210) 785-0888**. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the TxDOT to arrange.
