FM 1516 Expansion Project Overview

TxDOT is expanding 4 miles of FM 1516 from FM 78 (Old Seguin Rd.) to I-10 in east Bexar County.

The project is a \$68 million investment aimed at improving safety, enhancing traffic flow, and reducing congestion, benefiting the traveling public.

The FM 1516 Expansion project will transform the current two-lane road into a safer, more efficient four-lane roadway with a dedicated center turn lane and many other improvements.

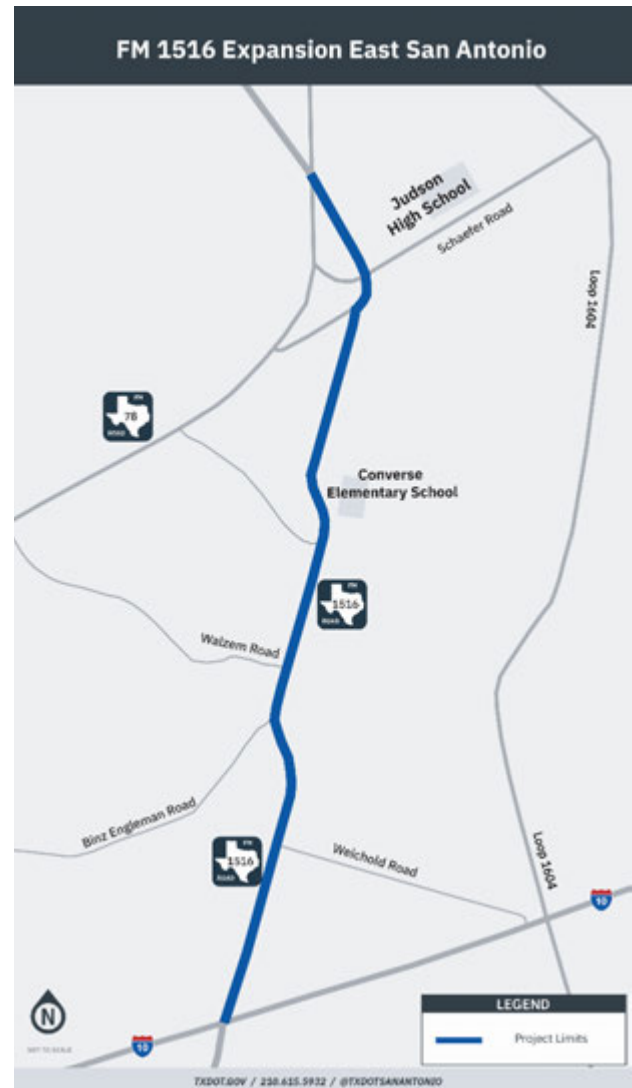
This project aims to enhance traffic flow, minimize delays, and improve safety for the traveling public. The project began in 2024 and is estimated to be completed by the end of 2028. The contractor is Jordan Foster Construction.

Project Improvements:

- Expansion from two lanes to four lanes
- Continuous center turn lane
- New asphalt surface
- Dedicated bike lanes
- Sidewalks

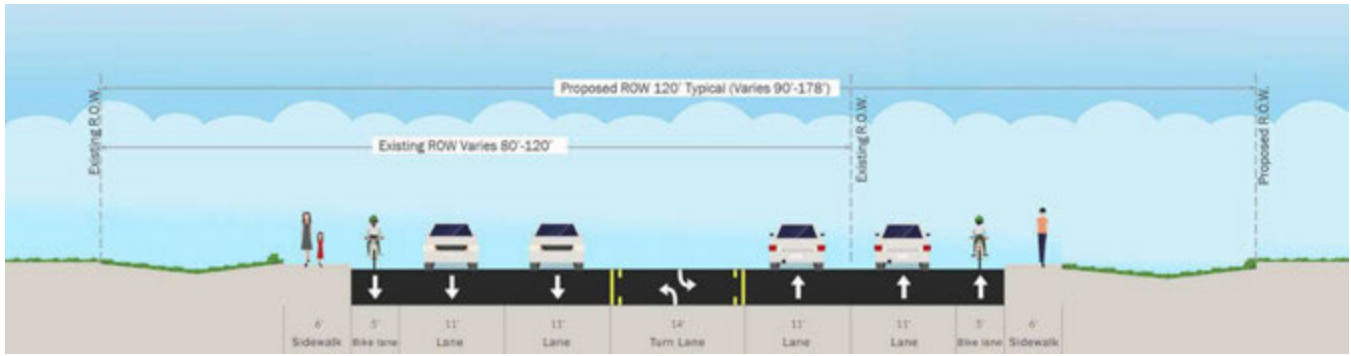

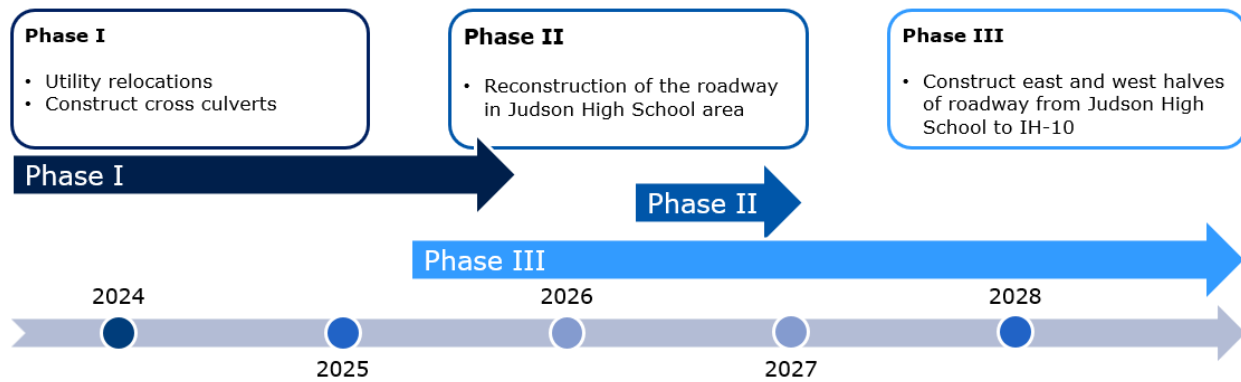

Project Timeline



Crews are currently relocating utilities, improving drainage, and building a temporary pavement section on the west side of the road. Once this portion is complete, traffic will shift to the west side, allowing workers to begin constructing new pavement on the east side.

Work Currently Planned for 2025

- Utilities
- Drainage
- Building culverts
- Building a detour on the west side



The two-lane roadway will soon become a five-lane roadway with a left-center turn lane and sidewalks.
