

Notice of Construction

I-35 Brooklyn Ave./McCullough Ave. Exit Ramp

TxDOT is moving forward with a construction project to repair the I-35 exit ramp to Brooklyn Ave./McCullough Ave. (exit ramp #157B). The project will include work to demolish and rebuild the exit ramp along southbound I-35 from Atlanta Ave. to Brooklyn Ave.

Construction is scheduled from the end of May 2024 until fall 2024. Once complete, this project will allow the exit ramp to reopen to traffic.

Construction Closures

What: Long-term closure of the southbound I-35 frontage road (E. Elmira St.)

Where: From Atlanta Ave. to Brooklyn Ave. Erie Ave. will also be closed to through traffic.

When: End of May 2024 until fall 2024

Detour: Traffic on the frontage road will take Atlanta Ave. to Euclid Ave., travel to Brooklyn Ave. and re-enter the frontage road.

Garbage pickup access will be maintained at the corner of Erie Ave. and Euclid Ave.



Digital message boards placed along the project will alert drivers to closures, traffic and construction activity.
