From State Highway (SH) 16 to Interstate Highway (I) 35

This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed Loop 1604 Improvement Project, and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project would expand Loop 1604 from State Highway (SH) 16 to Interstate Highway (I) 35 in Bexar County, Texas. The purpose of the project is to accommodate current and future traffic volumes on Loop 1604 from SH 16 to I-35.
