

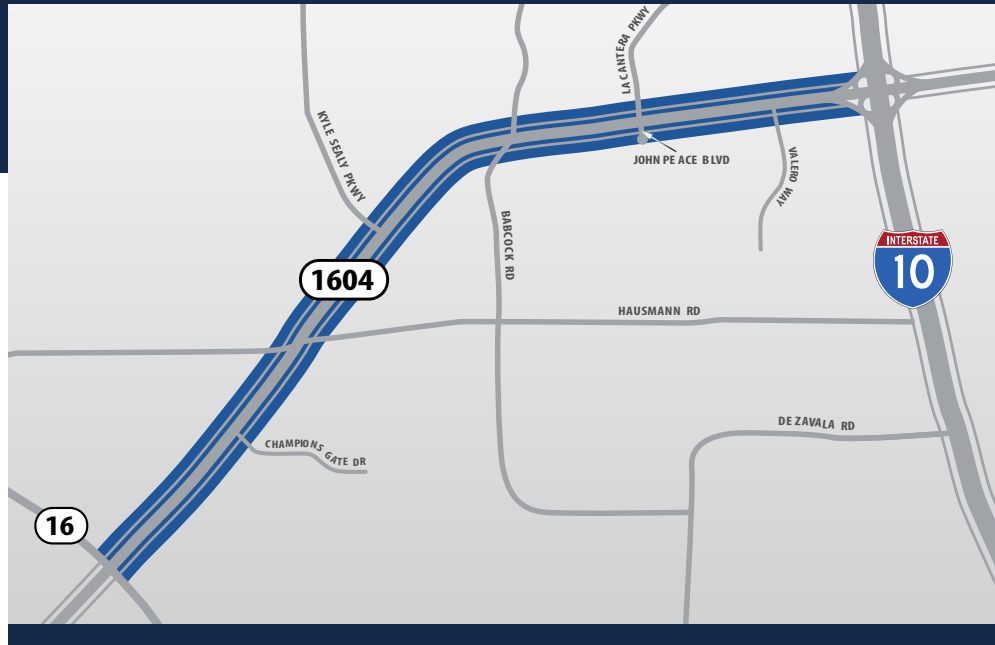


## Segment 1 – SH 16 (Bandera Rd.) to I-10

### Segment 1 Overview

As part of the larger Loop 1604 North Expansion project, Segment 1 includes several transportation improvements designed to increase mobility, reduce congestion and enhance safety along the Loop 1604 corridor from SH 16 (Bandera Rd.) to I-10. Major planned improvements for this segment include:

- Expansion of main lanes from a four-lane expressway to a ten-lane expressway with the addition of two general purpose lanes
- Addition of one high-occupancy vehicle (HOV) lane in each direction
- Layout reconfiguration of auxiliary lanes and entrance and exit ramps
- Accommodations for bicyclists and pedestrians, water quality protection and other highway features



### Why Improvements Are Needed

The purpose of the Loop 1604 North Expansion project is to accommodate current and future traffic volumes along the corridor. In Segment 1 alone, current traffic volumes estimate that over 127,000 drivers travel on the corridor each day. By 2045, Segment 1

could see daily traffic volumes almost double to 243,000. The planned improvements for Segment 1 of this project are designed to bring more mobility and less congestion for area drivers.

# What to Expect

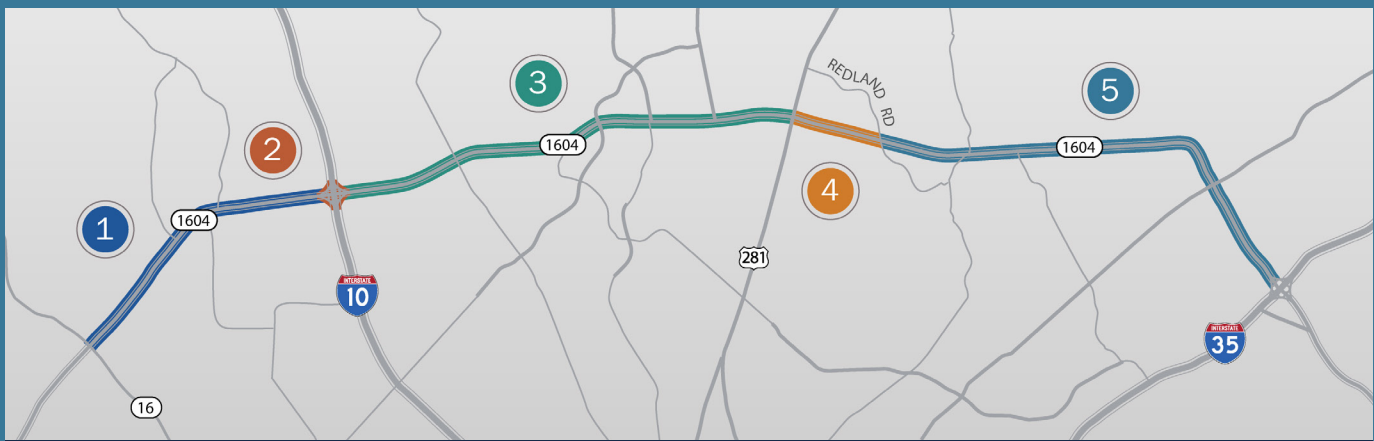
Throughout construction, drivers will experience temporary traffic shifts and overnight lane closures on the mainlanes and frontage roads, as well as temporary daytime and overnight closures.

Daytime work is anticipated to take place Mondays through Saturdays, while nighttime work and any necessary lane closures are anticipated to take place between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m., Sunday evenings through Friday mornings.

Permanent and temporary digital message boards placed along the corridor will alert drivers in real-time to lane closures, traffic congestion and construction activity. For the latest on construction closures and traffic shifts, follow us on social media.

## Loop 1604 North Expansion Project

The Loop 1604 North Expansion project is a \$1 billion investment in 23-miles of transportation improvements along the Loop 1604 corridor from SH 16 (Bandera Rd.) to I-35 in north Bexar County.
