The City of Seguin (City), in cooperation with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), is proposing to construct a new-location extension of Rudeloff Road from Huber Road to SH 123 at FM 20 in Guadalupe County, Texas. This notice advises the public that the City will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person open house. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Thursday, November 3, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, scan the QR code or go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: [www.seguintexas.gov/rudeloff2](http://www.seguintexas.gov/rudeloff2). Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above until at least Friday, November 18, 2022 at 11:59 p.m. If you do not have internet access, you may call Michael Sharp at (830) 386-2585 between the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.



Additionally, the City is holding an in-person open house for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of City staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. **The in-person open house will be held on Thursday, November 3, 2022 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Seguin Utilities Operation Center - Main Meeting Room, 3027 N. Austin St., Seguin, Texas 78155.**

The proposed project is needed due to inadequate regional system connectivity between SH 46 and SH 123 at FM 20 and on to SH 130 resulting from (a) population growth, (b) ongoing development within the proposed project area, and (c) emergency closures on I-10 that illustrate a need for an alternate route around I-10. The federal National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process requires that the City of Seguin evaluate various alternatives to enhance regional system connectivity between SH 46 and SH 123 at FM 20 and on to SH 130. The purpose of the virtual public meeting with an in-person open house is to gather input on the alternatives considered.

Additional right of way is anticipated to be required for the proposed project. However, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the City of Seguin by calling Michael Sharp at (830) 386-2585.

Any maps and drawings showing the project location and alternatives, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the City of Seguin's Capital Projects Department, 108 E. Mountain St., Seguin, TX 78155. Project materials are also available online at

[www.seguintexas.gov/rudeloff2](http://www.seguintexas.gov/rudeloff2). These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person open house.

The virtual public meeting and in-person open house will be conducted in English and Spanish. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English or Spanish, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting or in-person open house, please contact Jackie Lopez at (210) 349-3273 no later than 4 p.m. CT, on Tuesday, November 1, 2022. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the City to arrange.
