Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Open House Option
SH 123
From Cordova Road to I 10

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to expand State Highway (SH) 123 from Cordova Road to Interstate (I) 10 in Guadalupe County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person open house option. The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Tuesday March 15, 2022, at 5 pm. To view the virtual public meeting materials, go to txdot.gov keyword search "SH 123 from Cordova" at the date and time indicated above. Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above until at least March 30, 2022 at 12 midnight. If you do not have internet access, you may call (210) 494-0088 between the hours of 8 am and 5 pm, Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person open house option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online virtual public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants from a socially distanced approach, and leave written comments. The in-person open house format allows the public to come and go and there will be no formal presentation. The in-person open house option will be held on Tuesday March 15, 2022, from 5 pm to 7 pm at The Big Red Barn, located at 390 Cordova Rd, Seguin, TX 78155.

The proposed SH 123 roadway would consist of two 12-foot-wide main lanes in each direction separated by a raised median, and five-foot-wide shoulders with six-foot sidewalks from Cordova Road to I-10. Within the project limits, SH 123 is typically a two-lane, undivided highway with one twelve-foot-wide travel lane in each direction and ten-foot-wide outside shoulders. The typical right-of-way width is approximately 140 to 220 feet.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained by calling our public involvement consultant, Karen Coopersmith with Jacobs Engineering, at (210) 494-0088.

Any environmental documentation or studies, any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 am and 5 pm at the TxDOT San Antonio District Office, 4615 NW Loop 410, San Antonio, Texas 78229-0928, (210) 615-1110. Project materials are also available online at txdot.gov, keyword search "SH 123 from Cordova." These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person open house option.

The virtual public meeting and in-person open house option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty

communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting or in-person option, please contact (210) 494-0088 no later than 4 pm CST on March 9, 2022. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the Texas Department of Transportation to arrange.

Written comments may also be submitted by email to sh123cordova10@outlook.com. All comments must be received on or before March 30, 2022, to be included in the summary report.
