The Texas Department of Transportation is conducting a study to identify design concepts for SH 16 (Bandera Road) from I-410 to Loop 1604 within the cities of Leon Valley and San Antonio in Bexar County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online, virtual public meeting on the study. The virtual public meeting will be posted on Tuesday, June 29, 2021, at 5 p.m. To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov) at the date and time indicated above and enter keywords "[SH 16 \(Bandera Road\)](#)." TxDOT will provide a pre-recorded presentation that will include both audio and visual components. Please note that the presentation will not be available on the website until the time and date listed above. If you do not have internet access, please call Linda Vela at (210) 349-3273 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions or access virtual public meeting materials. Formal comments may be provided by mail, email, or at [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov), keywords "[SH 16 \(Bandera Road\)](#)." All comments must be received on or before Wednesday, July 14, 2021.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss roadway corridor concepts that could be applied throughout SH 16 (Bandera Road) from I-410 to Loop 1604. Options for improvements that could help alleviate traffic congestion and improve safety will also be presented and discussed. According to the Texas A&M Transportation Institute's 2020 rankings, this 6.5 mile stretch of road is one of the top 15 most congested roadways in the region.

The goals of the proposed improvements are to improve mobility, safety, and community connectivity while reducing congestion on the SH 16 (Bandera Road) corridor; and to accommodate multimodal transportation including bicyclists and pedestrians.
