Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Open House  
SH 16 (Bandera Road)  
From I-410 to Loop 1604

Bexar County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation is conducting a study to identify design concepts for SH 16 (Bandera Road) from I-410 to Loop 1604 within the cities of Leon Valley and San Antonio in Bexar County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online, virtual public meeting on the study with an in-person open house. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Wednesday, Oct. 26, 2022, at 6 p.m.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov) at the date and time indicated above and enter keywords "[SH 16 \(Bandera Road\)](#)." Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above until at least Thursday, Nov. 10, 2022. If you do not have internet access, please contact Laura Lopez at (210) 615-5839 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access study materials during the study development process. All comments must be postmarked and/or received on or before Thursday Nov. 10, 2022 to be included in the meeting summary.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person open house for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the virtual public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of study materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants from a socially distanced approach, and leave written comments. **The in-person open house will be held on Wednesday, Oct. 26, 2022, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at CityChurch, 9431 Bandera Rd, San Antonio, Texas, 78250.**

The purpose of this public meeting is to provide proposed roadway corridor concepts that could be applied throughout SH 16 (Bandera Road) from I-410 to Loop 1604. In addition, concept layouts will also be shown at the open house with options for improvements that could help alleviate traffic congestion and improve safety within the study limits. This will be the third public meeting held for the SH 16 (Bandera Road) Study. According to the Texas A&M Transportation Institute's 2021 rankings, this 6.5 mile stretch of road is one of the top 15 most congested roadways in the region.

The goals of the proposed concepts are to improve mobility, safety, and community connectivity while reducing congestion on the SH 16 (Bandera Road) corridor, and to accommodate multimodal transportation including bicyclists and pedestrians.
