



Notice and Opportunity to Comment
SH 16 from Robindale East Road to Old San Antonio Road
CSJs: 0291-06-053
Bandera County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to expand SH 16 from Robindale East Road to Old San Antonio Road in Bandera County, Texas. This notice is affording an opportunity to comment as part of the environmental review process for this project. If you are a property owner, you are receiving this notice because records indicate that you own property that is adjacent to the project. This notice and opportunity to comment is also being provided to affected local governments and public officials.

TxDOT proposes to expand this section of SH 16 from one lane each way to two 12-ft wide lanes each way with five-ft wide shoulders and sidewalks on each side. The opposing lanes would typically be divided by a center turn lane. A raised median would be located on SH 16 between the eastern unsignalized intersection of Old San Antonio Road and Enchanted River Drive. The bridge over Bandera Creek would be replaced with a wider and higher structure to reduce the frequency of overtopping. All of the work would be located within the existing public rights-of-way.

TxDOT hosted a public meeting on this project in November 2017. TxDOT made minor changes to the project after this meeting; however, TxDOT was not able to advance the project until funding was recently identified. The project is tentatively planned for construction letting in December 2022. Construction typically commences two to three months after letting.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the Texas Department of Transportation San Antonio District Headquarters located at 4615 NW Loop 410, San Antonio, Texas, 78229. Project materials are also available online at www.txdot.gov search "SH 16 from Robindale".

The project materials are written in English.
