The Texas Department of Transportation San Antonio District is proposing to improve State Highway 46 from I-35 to I-10 and I-35 from South Walnut Avenue to FM 306 in Comal and Guadalupe counties, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online, virtual public meeting with in-person open houses to gather public input on the project. **The virtual public meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Tuesday, Jan. 24, 2023, at 5 p.m.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov) at the date and time indicated above and enter keywords "SH 46 from I-35 to I-10". If you do not have internet access, please contact Kari Sutton at (210) 349-3273, ext. 133 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, for assistance in accessing project materials.

TxDOT is also conducting in-person open houses for individuals who would like to participate in-person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the virtual public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants from a socially distanced approach, and leave written comments. **The in-person open houses will be held on Tuesday, Jan. 24, 2023, from 5-7 p.m. at the New Braunfels Civic/Convention Center, 375 S. Castell Ave., New Braunfels, Texas, 78130 and on Thursday, Jan. 26, 2023, from 5-7 p.m. at The Big Red Barn, 390 Cordova Rd., Seguin, Texas, 78155.**

Improvements along SH 46 are needed to meet current and future traffic volumes and regional population growth. The purpose of the project is to reduce congestion, improve mobility and increase safety along SH 46. TxDOT is proposing to expand SH 46 with operational and corridor improvements including additional lanes, overpasses and intersection improvements. The proposed expansion also includes limited ramp reconstruction along I-35.

The SH 46 existing typical right-of-way width is 120 feet. Recommended improvements to expand SH 46 would require additional right of way and potentially displace residential and non-residential structures. All recommended improvements are draft and subject to change. Relocation assistance is available for displaced persons and businesses. Information about the TxDOT Relocation Assistance Program including services and benefits for potentially affected property owners, as well as information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction, can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling Michael Garza at (210) 615-6288.

Public input will be considered as TxDOT moves forward in developing a plan to improve safety and mobility on this corridor while preparing for future growth. Project materials are available online at [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov), keywords "SH 46 from I-35 to I-10". These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person open houses.

The virtual public meeting and in-person open houses will be conducted in English and Spanish. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English or Spanish is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English or Spanish, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting or in-person open houses, please contact **Kari Sutton, at (210) 349-3273, ext. 133 no later than 4 p.m., Wednesday, Jan. 18, 2023.** Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for TxDOT to arrange.
