The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to expand and reconstruct State Loop (SL) 1604 from Macdona Lacoste Road to U.S. Highway 90 in Bexar County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person open house option. **The virtual public meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Tuesday, April 26, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov) - search keyword: SL 1604 from Macdona. Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person open house option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. **The in-person open house option will be held on Thursday, April 28, 2022, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the TxDOT San Antonio District Office located at 4615 Northwest Loop 410, Building 2, San Antonio, Texas 78229.**

The approximate 3.8-mile proposed project improvements include construction of an additional travel lanes to the west of the existing roadway and reconstruction of the existing travel lanes to create a 4-lane, general purpose divided highway. The general purpose divided highway consisting of two 12-ft. wide travel lanes in each direction with 10-ft. outside shoulder and 4-ft. inside shoulder from the Medina River to US 90 in Bexar County, Texas. All intersections will be converted to a Restricted-Crossing-U-Turn intersections, where side-street exiting is restricted to right-turns only, and turnarounds are constructed to complete the left-turn and through maneuvers. The existing Medina River bridge will remain in place, and a second bridge will be constructed to the west for the additional lanes. South of the Medina River, the roadway will transition back to the existing 2-lane undivided highway. The existing ROW varies from 220-ft. to 720-ft., therefore no additional right of way will be acquired for the proposed improvements.

The proposed project would involve construction in wetlands.

The proposed project would involve an action in a floodplain.
