TALLEY ROAD PHASE II

From Wiseman Boulevard to Tamaron Pass

Bexar County, in cooperation with the Texas Department of Transportation San Antonio District (TxDOT), is proposing to expand Talley Road from Wiseman Boulevard to Tamaron Pass in Bexar County, Texas. This notice advises the public that Bexar County will be conducting a virtual public meeting on the proposed project. The virtual public meeting will be available on the Bexar County website beginning March 2, 2021 at 5 p.m. To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: www.bexar.org/1380/Public-Works-Department. Project staff will give a presentation which will be a pre-recorded video and will include both audio and visual components. Please note that the presentation will not be available on the website until the time and date listed above. If you do not have internet access, you may call Amy Esguerra, CP&Y Environmental Lead, 210-798-2323, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process. Formal comments will be accepted until March 17, 2021 by mail or email as explained below.

The purpose of the virtual public meeting is to present the proposed project to the public and receive comments. The proposed project would upgrade approximately 2.4 miles of Talley Road to meet current design standards and accommodate increased traffic in the area from Wiseman Boulevard to Tamaron Pass in northwest Bexar County. The existing roadway consists of one 12-foot wide travel lane in each direction with 2-foot wide shoulders on each side of the roadway, with the total right-of-way width varying between 60 and 86 feet wide. The proposed roadway improvements would consist of two 15-foot wide shared use lanes, two 11-foot wide travel lanes, and one continuous 14-foot wide left turn lane, with the total right-of-way width varying between 76 and 90 feet wide. Additionally, 5-foot sidewalks would be located along both sides of the roadway for the entire length of the project area. The upgrade would include drainage improvements as well. This portion of Talley Road will match the Talley Road Phase I footprint currently under construction.

Within project limits the proposed project would improve traffic operations and mobility, accommodate development in the area, and address the lack of pedestrian and bicycle facilities by adding capacity, providing operational improvements, and adding a sidewalk along Talley Road.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time.
