US 181 from Palm Park Blvd to Eagle Creek Ranch Blvd

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing improvements to US 181 from Palm Park Blvd to Eagle Creek Ranch Blvd in Bexar and Wilson Counties, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an open house on the proposed project.

TxDOT is providing an open house to participate in person instead of online. Open house attendees will be able to review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. **The open house will be held on Thursday, August 1, from 5 to 7 p.m. at St. Anthony Catholic Church & Event Hall, 16505 Kilowatt Rd, Elmendorf, TX 78112.**

Meeting materials will be available online from Thursday, August 1 to Thursday, August 15. To view the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: **www.txdot.gov, keyword search "US 181 from Palm Park."** If you do not have internet access, you may call (210) 463-4402 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

TxDOT is proposing improvements to an approximately seven-mile long segment of US 181 from Palm Park Blvd to Eagle Creek Ranch Blvd in San Antonio, Bexar and Wilson Counties. The purpose of the proposed project is to improve safety for vehicular traffic and reduce the conflict points where crashes are most likely to happen. The roadway currently consists of two lanes in each direction separated by a grassy median with crossovers at several cross streets. TxDOT proposes to close the crossovers and install unsignalized U-turn lanes. All improvements would be constructed within the existing right of way.

Any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT San Antonio District Office located at 4615 NW Loop 410, San Antonio, TX 78229-0928. The San Antonio District office phone number is (210) 615-5839. Project materials are also available online at www.txdot.gov, keyword search "US 181 from Palm Park. These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review by those attending the open house in person.

The open house will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
