VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING WITH IN-PERSON OPEN HOUSE OPTION

**US 87 Widening Project
From Bexar/Wilson County line to FM 1346
CSJ: 0143-03-049
Wilson County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing roadway and drainage improvements to US 87 by upgrading to a four-lane divided highway from the Bexar/Wilson County line to FM 1346 in Wilson County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person open house option. **The virtual public meeting materials will be posted online on Tuesday, March 29, 2022 at 5 p.m.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: www.txdot.gov, keyword search "US 87 from Bexar". Following the virtual public meeting, the materials will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above through the comment period deadline of Wednesday, April 13, 2022 at 11:59 p.m. If you do not have internet access, you may call (972) 960-4431 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person open house option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same materials delivered in the online public meeting, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants from a socially distanced approach, and leave written comments. **The in-person open house option will be held on Tuesday, March 29, 2022 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at Grace Bible Church, 390 FM 1346 S, La Vernia, TX 78121.**

The proposed project, subject to final design considerations, would require additional right of way and potentially displace one residence and three non-residential structures. Relocation assistance is available for displaced persons and businesses. Information about the TxDOT Relocation Assistance Program and services and benefits for those displaced and other affected property owners, as well as information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction, can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling (210) 615-6288. The proposed project would involve an action in a floodplain.

The virtual public meeting and in-person open house option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting or in-person open house option, please contact Gwen Jurisich at (972) 960-4431 no later than 4 p.m. CT, March 24, 2022. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the Texas Department of Transportation to arrange.
