This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed US 90 project, and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project would reconstruct and widen US 90 from State Highway (SH) 211 to State Loop (LP) 13 (also known as West Military Drive) in Bexar County, Texas.

The FONSI and approved final environmental assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT San Antonio District Office, 4615 NW Loop 410, San Antonio, TX 78229-0928 and by phone at (210) 615-5839. They are also available online at txdot.gov. In the upper right-hand search box, enter the search keywords "US 90 from SH 211".
