



NOTICE PUBLIC HEARING I-10 Westbound at Exit 365 Crockett County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to relocate the eastbound I-10 exit ramp 365 to a point approximately 0.8 miles west of its current location extending to SH 163 in Crockett County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a public hearing on the proposed project. The hearing will be held on Thursday, May 10, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. at the Crockett County Courthouse, Main Courtroom, 907 Avenue D, Ozona, Texas 76943. Displays will be available for viewing at 5:30 p.m. with the formal hearing starting at 6:00 p.m. The purpose of the hearing is to present the planned improvements and to receive public comment on the proposed project.

TxDOT will present plans to relocate the I-10 eastbound exit ramp 365 to a point 0.8 miles west of its current location. These plans include the construction of new frontage road from the new ramp location to the existing frontage road including a bridge that will span Johnson Draw. The existing ramp will be removed and the current frontage road will be converted from two-way to one-way. The project is designed to increase safety of I-10 eastbound exiting traffic by allowing for more deceleration time and weaving distance between I-10 and SH 163. The project will also allow safe entry and exit for the community south of I-10 and west of Johnson Draw during flood conditions. No new Right-of-Way will be acquired for this project.

Environmental documentation for the project will be available for inspection at the hearing. This information will also be available Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT San Angelo District Office, 4502 Knickerbocker Road, San Angelo, TX 76904. Verbal and written comments are requested and may be presented at the hearing or by mail to John DeWitt, P.E., at 4502 Knickerbocker Road, San Angelo, TX 76904, or by email to john.dewitt@txdot.gov. Comments must be received on or before May 25, 2018 to be part of the official hearing record. If you have any general questions or concerns regarding the proposed project or the hearing, please contact John DeWitt.

The hearing will be conducted in English. Requests should be made at least two days prior to the hearing. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate these needs.

The environmental review, consultation and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated Dec. 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
