Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option**

**San Angelo North Relief Route  
From US 87 to US 67

Tom Green County, Texas**

As part of the Ports-to-Plains Corridor initiative, TxDOT is proposing to construct a relief route on new location from United States Highway (US) 87 to US 67 in Tom Green County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person option. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Wednesday, Oct. 23, 2024, at 12 p.m., and will remain online until Thursday, Nov. 7, 2024.** To view the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov), keyword search: "San Angelo North Relief Route". If you do not have internet access, you may call Russell Pehl, PE, CFM, TxDOT project manager, (325) 944-1501 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. The in-person option will be held in a traditional public meeting format. In-person attendees will be able to attend an in-person presentation by TxDOT staff, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. **The in-person option will be held Wednesday, Oct. 23, 2024, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the San Angelo TxDOT District Office, Building E, 4502 Knickerbocker Road, San Angelo, TX 76904.**

The proposed project's conceptual route identified as a result of a feasibility study completed in December 2022, which accommodates both TxDOT's Ports-to-Plains initiative and potential IH-14 future routing and has been carried into the schematic and environmental analysis stage. The project would evaluate alignment alternatives for an approximately 500-foot-wide right of way (ROW) within a 1,200-foot-wide study corridor that extends for approximately 11 miles on new location between US 87 and US 67 north of San Angelo. The proposed roadway would consist of three mainlanes in each direction with two-lane frontage roads on either side and would include interchanges at US 87, US 277, and US 67, as well as grade-separated intersections at other state and local roads. The proposed project would involve construction in wetlands and would involve action in a floodplain.

The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require additional right of way and potentially displace two residences. Relocation assistance is available for displaced persons and businesses. Information about the TxDOT Relocation Assistance Program and services and benefits for those displaced and other affected property owners, as well as information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction, can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling (325) 944-1501.

Any environmental documentation or studies, any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the San Angelo District Office, 4502 Knickerbocker Road, San Angelo, Texas 76904. Project materials are also available online at [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov). These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person option.
