TxDOT will be conducting an open house to share information and gather public input regarding the replacement of five, off-system bridges in Runnels County. The meeting will be in an open house format and the public is invited to come and go at their convenience. TxDOT staff will be available to answer questions.

Two of the bridges are historic pony truss style bridges and available for adoption through TxDOT's Historic Bridge Legacy Program. More information is available on www.txdot.gov, keywords "Bridge Legacy."

The bridges to be replaced are:

- CR 114 over Pony Creek—Bridge-class culvert
- CR 128 over Mustang Creek—Historic pony truss
- CR 216 over Oak Creek—Historic pony truss
- CR 301 over Valley Creek—Concrete slab bridge
- CR 272 over Valley Creek—Concrete slab bridge
