Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option**

From FM 2291 South of Menard to I-10 North of Junction

Menard and Kimble counties, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) San Angelo District is proposing to widen United States Highway (US) 83 from Farm to Market (FM) 2291 south of Menard to I-10 north of Junction in Menard and Kimble counties, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person option. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Thursday, April 25, 2024, at noon.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: www.txdot.gov and search "US 83 Menard to Junction". Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above until at least Friday, May 10, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. If you do not have internet access, you may call Russell Pehl, P.E., CFM, TxDOT Project Manager, at (325) 944-1501 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants from a socially distanced approach, and leave written comments. **The in-person option will be held on Thursday, April 25, 2024 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Junction High School Gym, 1700 College Street, Junction, Texas 76849.**

The proposed project would extend for approximately 26 miles along US 83, which currently consists of a rural, two-lane undivided highway with alternating Super-2 passing lanes within a 120-foot-wide right of way. The proposed project would evaluate alignment alternatives to widen US 83 within a 370-foot-wide right of way. The proposed project would be constructed in two phases; Phase I (interim design) would primarily widen US 83 to a four-lane divided highway; Phase II (ultimate design) would widen US 83 to a controlled-access interstate system by constructing frontage roads on either side of the interim design mainlanes.

The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require additional right of way and an analysis will be conducted to determine whether the proposed project would result in impacts to environmental resources or result in potential displacements, as the project develops. Relocation assistance will be available for displaced persons and businesses. Information about the TxDOT Relocation Assistance Program and services and benefits for those displaced and other affected property owners, as well as information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction, can be obtained from the TxDOT San Angelo District Office by calling Russell Pehl, P.E., CFM, TxDOT Project Manager, at (325) 944-1501.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT District Office at 4502 Knickerbocker Road San Angelo, TX 76904, and (325) 944-1501. Project materials will also be available for review at the in-person option.

The virtual public meeting and in-person option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
