#### **US 57 CORRIDOR INTERSTATE FEASIBILITY STUDY**

**From Eagle Pass International Bridge on the Texas-Mexico Border to I-35 in Moore, Texas.  
Maverick, Zavala, and Frio counties, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is assessing the feasibility of interstate designation for the 100-mile-long US 57 Corridor from the Eagle Pass International Bridge on the Texas-Mexico border eastward to the Interstate 35 (I-35) junction in Moore, Texas. The study is also assessing how to improve east/west connectivity, enhance safety and freight movement, and promote international trade and economic opportunity at the border and along the corridor. Findings and recommendations will assist in developing a phased and prioritized improvement strategy for the US 57 Corridor. **This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting for participants to obtain information on the feasibility study process and improvement options, as well as submit comments on corridor needs. There will not be an in-person option for this public meeting.**

The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and other visual components. The virtual public meeting will be available by 5 p.m. on Thursday, October 13, 2022. There will be no live meeting or presentation. Participants may view the pre-recorded presentation and other materials, and submit a comment at any time during the official public comment period.

If you do not have internet access, you may call TxDOT Project Manager Paul Truban, AICP at (512) 839-7256 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access virtual public meeting materials during the project development process. Formal comments may be submitted electronically through the virtual public meeting website or provided by mail or email as explained below.

The virtual public meeting will be conducted in English and Spanish. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English or Spanish is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English or Spanish, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting, please contact Paul Truban via the methods listed below no later than 4 p.m. on October 11, 2022. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the Texas Department of Transportation to arrange.
