



Notice of a Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Open Houses

Connecting Texas 2050 | Statewide Long-Range Transportation Plan

The Texas Department of Transportation is developing *Connecting Texas 2050*, the latest update to TxDOT's statewide long-range transportation plan. With the continued help of the community, TxDOT will establish the vision, objectives, performance measures, and strategic recommendations for the state's transportation system through 2050 for all modes. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a second statewide virtual public meeting with local in-person open houses in the fall of 2023.

The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online Tuesday, Oct. 17, 2023, by 5 p.m. To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at or after the date and time indicated above: www.ConnectingTexas2050.com. Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above until Friday, Dec. 22, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. If you do not have internet access, leave a message at (512) 271-2025 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access planning materials during the transportation plan development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing in-person open houses for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments.

Notice of a Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Options

During the current public meeting series, you can learn about the process to prepare a statewide long-range transportation plan and help TxDOT prioritize strategies for addressing the state's transportation needs through 2050. Connecting Texas 2050 development kicked off in fall 2022 and will continue through spring 2024.

The virtual public meeting with in-person open houses will be conducted in English, with Spanish materials available. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting or in-person option, provide TxDOT advance notice by calling 512-271-2025 by 4 p.m. CT at least three working days prior to the in-person open house. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for TxDOT to arrange.

Feedback can be provided through an interactive survey at the in-person open houses or online. Comments can be submitted at each in-person open house, online, via e-mail or by postal mail. More information can be found online at www.ConnectingTexas2050.com. To be included in the public involvement summary, comments must be received or postmarked by Friday, Dec. 22, 2023.
