The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will be conducting a virtual public meeting for the 2021 Annual Bicycle Meeting for the TxDOT Tyler District.

**The virtual public meeting pre-recorded presentation will be available for viewing on Tuesday, Dec. 14, 2021 at 4 p.m.** This virtual meeting format (no in-person meeting) includes a pre-recorded video presentation and comment opportunity. The presentation will include both audio and visual components.

The purpose of this virtual public meeting is to provide information regarding transportation projects and programs that might affect bicycle use on the state system within the Tyler District.
