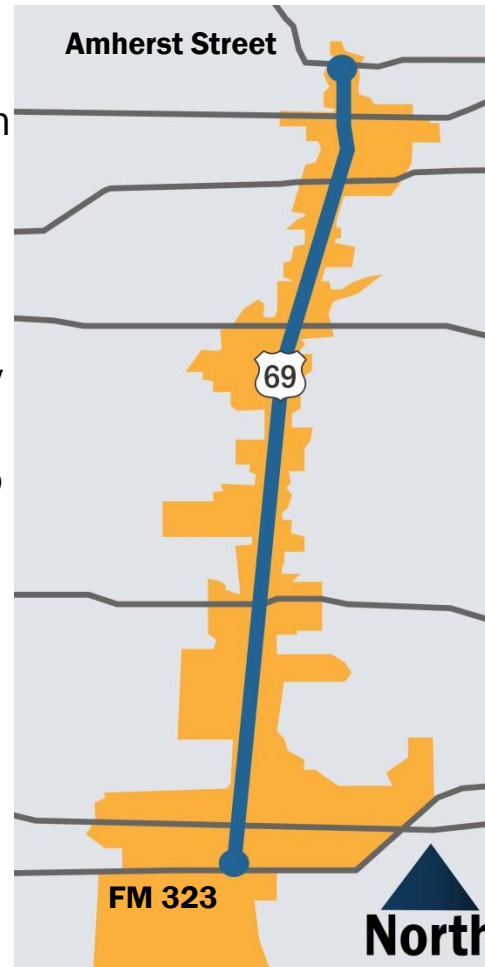


US 69 Feasibility Study

LEARN ABOUT THE US 69 FEASIBILITY STUDY

- The City of Tyler, the Tyler Area Metropolitan Planning Organization and TxDOT are conducting a feasibility study to explore improvements to US 69 (South Broadway Avenue) from Amherst Street to FM 2813.
- South Broadway Avenue from Loop 323 to Toll 49 is the most congested roadway in Smith County and the 67th most congested in Texas. Traffic is expected to almost double in the next 25 years.
- The study evaluates ways to enhance safety and improve mobility along the corridor. A relief route around Tyler and improvements to other roadways are not being considered.
