### **Notice and Opportunity to Comment**

**IH 14/US 190  
From FM 2410 to IH 35

Bell County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to expand Interstate Highway (IH) 14/US Highway (US) 190 from Farm-to-Market (FM) 2410 to IH 35 in Bell County, Texas. Pursuant to Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, §2.104 this notice is affording an opportunity to comment as part of the environmental review process for this project. If you are a property owner, you are receiving this notice because records indicate that you own property that (1) would be acquired (in part or in whole) for this project, or (2) is adjacent to the project. This notice and opportunity to comment is also being provided to affected local governments and public officials.

The proposed project would widen IH 14/US 190 from FM 2410 to IH 35 from four to six lanes by adding a third lane of through traffic in the existing median in each direction. Directions of travel would be separated by an approximately 28-foot-wide grassy median. Entrance and exit ramps would also be adjusted. The project length is approximately 5.14 miles. The purpose of the proposed project is to improve mobility and safety along the project corridor.

The existing right-of-way (ROW) is approximately 420 feet wide. No additional ROW would be required, and no residential or commercial displacements are proposed.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT Waco District office at 100 South Loop Drive, Waco, Texas 76704. You may submit comments covering the social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed location and design for this project. Comments must be received in writing on or before Friday, April 26, 2019.
