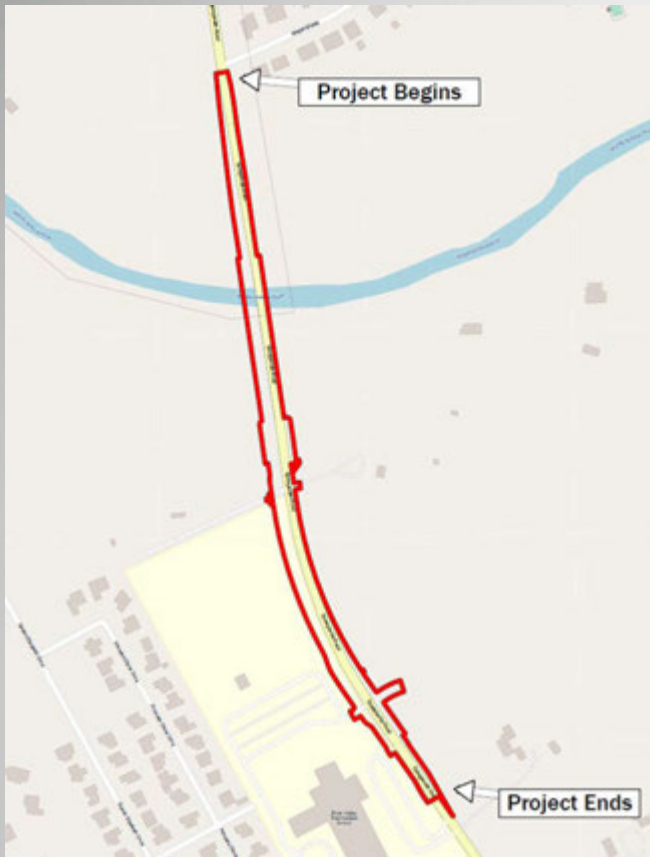


Speegleville Road Bridge at Middle Bosque River

Project Overview

Highway/Limits: Speegleville Road from Maple Shade Road to north of Oak Road, City of Waco, McLennan County

Project ID: 0909-22-224

Project Length: Approximately 0.61 miles of Speegleville Road

Description: The proposed project would reconstruct Speegleville Road and the bridge over the Middle Bosque River from Maple Shade Road to north of Oak Road. The new roadway would expand from the existing two-lane configuration to a four-lane divided highway separated by a grass median. The existing bridge over the Middle Bosque River would also be expanded to match the new facility and would be reconstructed from a single bridge crossing to a two-bridge crossing with each structure for single directional traffic only. Additionally, pedestrian walkways would be constructed on the east and west sides of the roadway.

Construction Cost: The proposed project would have an estimated construction cost of approximately \$17,300,000

Right of Way: The project would not require acquisition of additional right-of-way.
