The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing the installation of a new location roadway (Hamilton Truck / Relief Route) for US 281 from FM 3302 to CR 102 West of City of Hamilton, and from US 281 to SH 22 East of City of Hamilton in Hamilton County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an in-person and online virtual public meeting addressing this project. **The same information will be available at the in-person and virtual meeting.**

The in-person meeting will occur on Tuesday, September 24, 2024, at the Hamilton Junior High School Cafeteria at 5:30 p.m. from 7:30 p.m. and will be an open house format where the public may come and go at their convenience. Staff will be available to answer questions and accept comments. The virtual meeting can be viewed Tuesday, September 24, 2024, starting by 5:30 p.m. Materials will be posted to the project website listed above. You can also access the project website by scanning the QR code or by doing a keyword search for "US 281 Hamilton". Website materials will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation that includes both audio and video components, and other meeting exhibits. The virtual public meeting is not a live event and the materials can be viewed at your convenience. If you do not have internet access, you may call 254-867-2700 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials. **Please note the materials will not be available for review until Tuesday, September 24, 2024, at 5:30 p.m. online.**

The project would be approximately 12 miles in length. The proposed Hamilton Truck / Relief Route would be a four-lane divided roadway with non-continuous two-lane frontage roads and access ramps to major cross-streets. The proposed Hamilton Truck / Relief Route would require additional right of way to accommodate the construction of the project. Environmental studies are ongoing to determine the environmental impacts associated with constructing the Truck / Relief Route.

Any maps and drawings presenting the project and other information regarding the project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Waco District Office, 100 S. Loop Drive, Waco, TX 76704. Project and study materials are also available online at the project website.

The in-person and virtual public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting or in-person option, please contact the TxDOT Public Information Office at 254-867-2836 no later than 4 p.m. CST, Friday, September 20, 2024. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for TxDOT to arrange.
