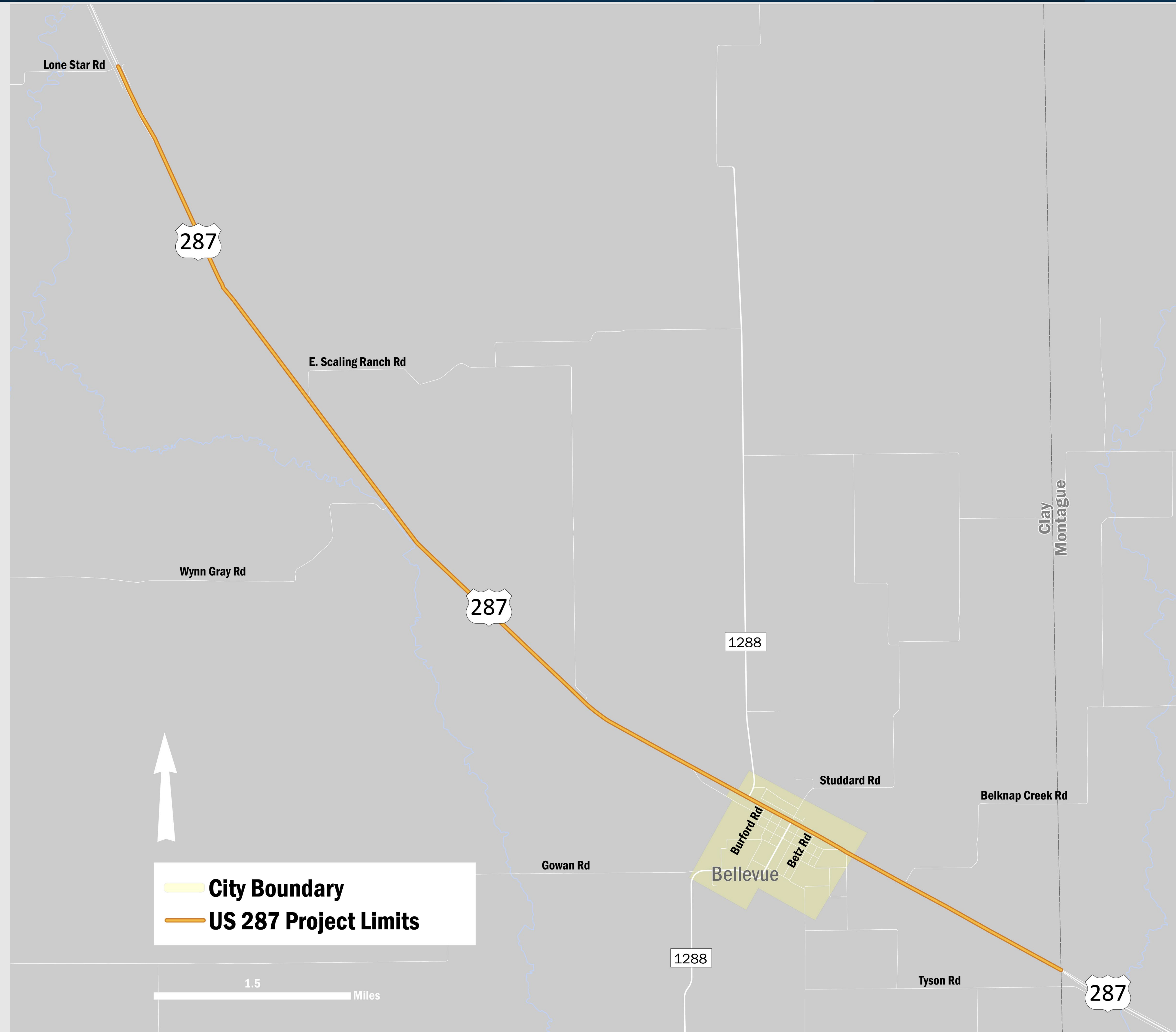

Project Overview

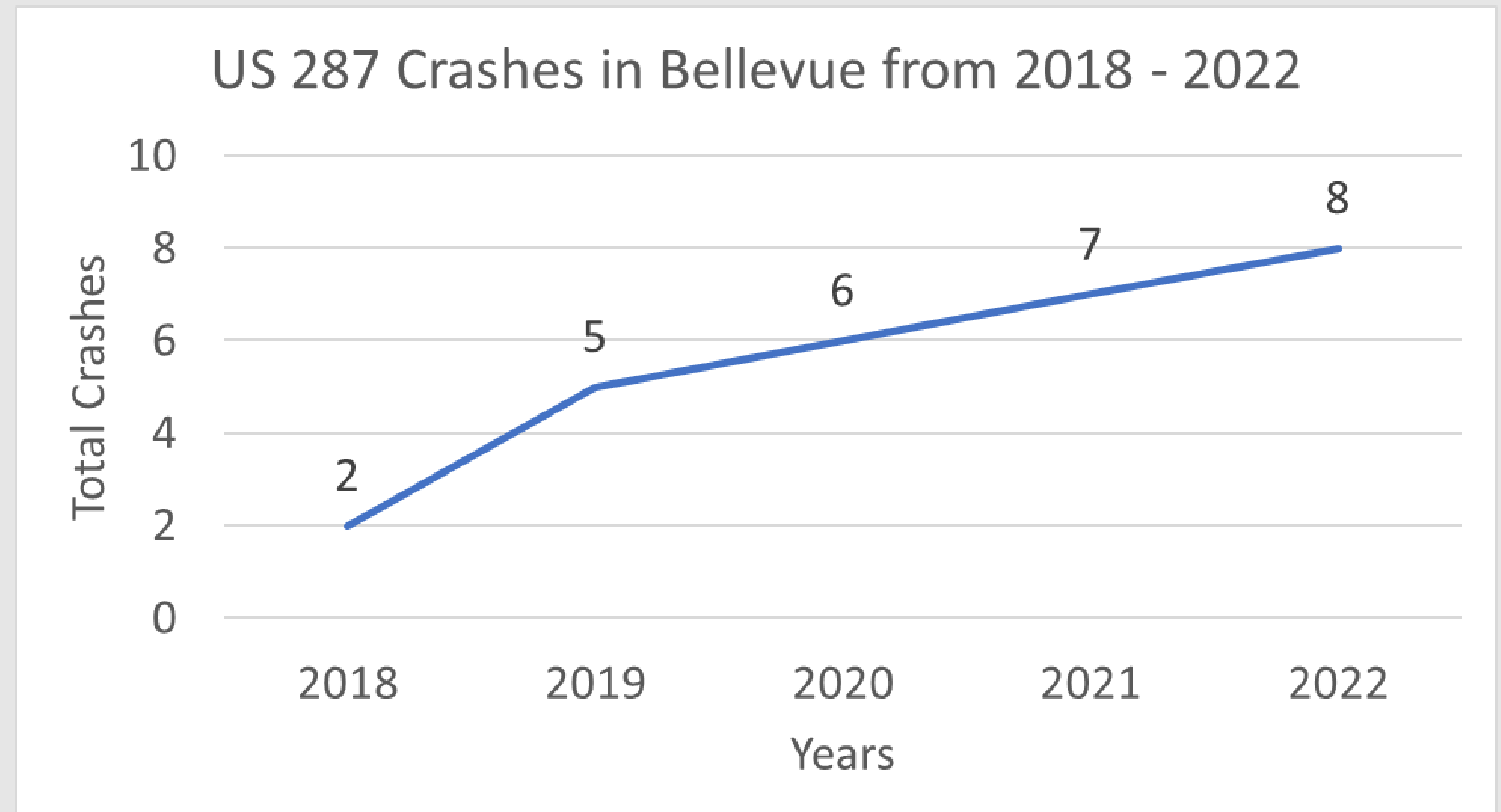


Proposed roadway rehabilitation along US 287 from Lone Star Road to the Montague County line

- Repair and resurface the US 287 Northbound mainlanes and shoulders (within the divided sections)
- Repair and resurface the US 287 mainlanes, shoulders, and frontage roadways within the city limits of Bellevue
- Install concrete traffic barriers at Burford St. and Betz St.
- Install advanced flashing beacons for 55 mph speed zone



- There are currently six city streets that have direct access to and from the mainlanes of US 287 from Clay St. to Betz St.
- Crash data 2018 - 2022:
 - There have been 28 crashes on US 287 within the city of Bellevue in the last five years
- Poor sight distance at the proposed closure locations
