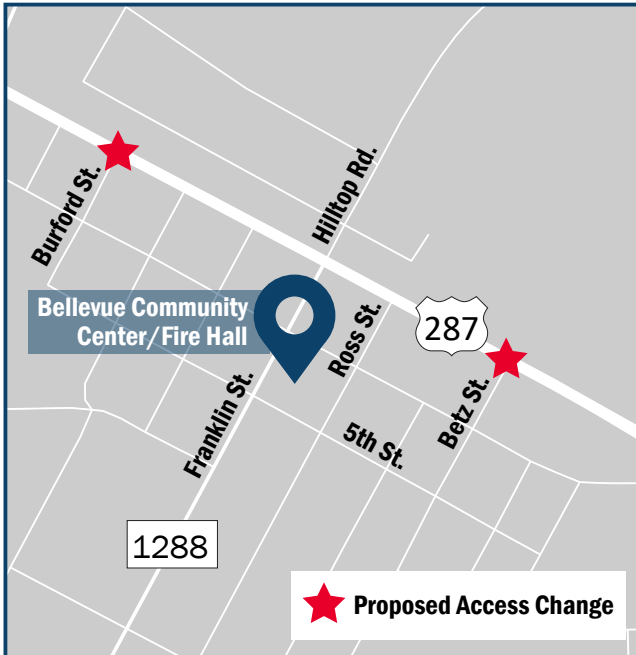

The Texas Department of Transportation invites you to attend a virtual public hearing with in-person option on US 287 in Clay County regarding the proposed extension of the existing concrete barriers to prevent direct access to and from Burford Street and Betz Street from the US 287 main lanes within the limits of the City of Bellevue. In addition to this work, the proposed project would repair and resurface the US 287 northbound main lanes and shoulders from Lone Star Road to the Montague County line, a distance of approximately 10 miles.

TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public hearing on the proposed project with an in-person option.

- **Virtual Option:** The virtual hearing will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The virtual public hearing is pre-recorded, and the materials can be viewed at your convenience.
- **In-Person Option:** At the in-person option, attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public hearing which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and leave written comments.
