Project Overview

TxDOT is proposing to widen and realign a 6.4-mile section of FM 102 from I-10 to approximately 0.66 miles south of FM 949 in Colorado County, Texas.

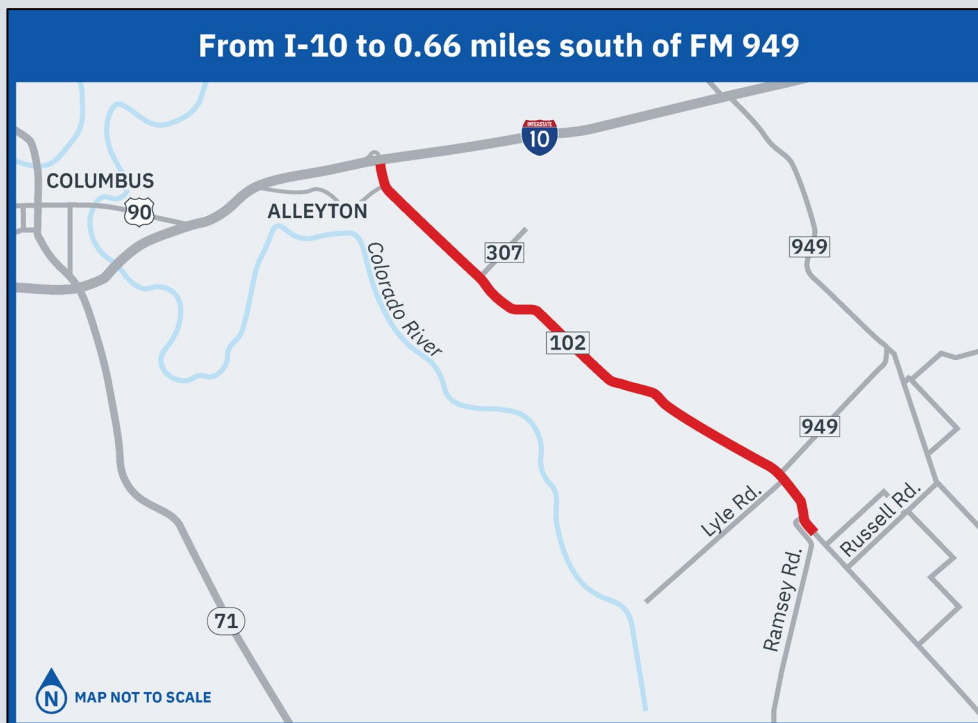
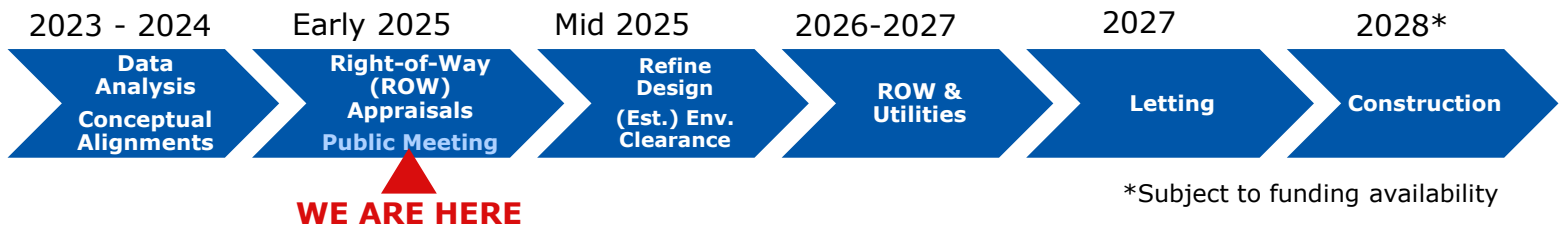
The proposed project would enhance safety and bring the roadway into compliance with current design standards. The corridor would maintain its existing two-lane footprint while widening the shoulders and rehabilitating existing curves. A typical slope ditch is proposed along both sides of FM 102 to accommodate drainage, along with various culvert replacements and improvements.

The proposed project would involve construction in wetlands and involve an action in a floodplain.

Project Need and Purpose

The project is needed because the existing roadway does not meet current design standards. The purpose of the project is to bring FM 102 from I-10 to 0.66 miles south of FM 949 into compliance with current design standards and enhance safety by realigning the curvature of the corridor.
