



## FM 102 From I-10 to 0.66 miles south of FM 949 Notice of In-Person Public Meeting with Virtual Option

TxDOT is proposing to widen and realign a 6.4-mile section of FM 102 from I-10 to 0.66 miles south of FM 949 in Colorado County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an in-person public meeting on the proposed project with an online virtual option. The in-person option will be held in an open house format. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the virtual online public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions to TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. **The in-person option will be held on Thursday, Jan. 9 from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. at Columbus High School Cafeteria, 103 Cardinal Lane, Columbus, TX 78934.**

Additionally, TxDOT is providing a virtual option for individuals who cannot make the in-person meeting and instead would like to participate virtually. The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. **The presentation will be posted online by Thursday, Jan. 9, 2025, at 4:30 p.m. and will remain online through Friday, Jan. 24, 2025.** To view the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: [www.TxDOT.gov](http://www.TxDOT.gov), keyword search: "FM 102 from I-10 to 0.66 miles south of FM 949". If you do not have internet access, you may call 361-293-4328 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

The proposed project would enhance safety and bring the roadway into compliance with current design standards. The corridor would maintain its existing two-lane footprint while widening the shoulders and rehabilitating existing curves. A typical slope ditch is proposed along both sides of FM 102 to accommodate drainage, along with various culvert replacements and improvements. The proposed project would involve construction in wetlands and involve an action in a floodplain.

The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require additional right of way and potentially displace one residence. Relocation assistance is available for displaced persons and businesses. Information about the TxDOT Relocation Assistance Program and services and benefits for those displaced and other affected property owners, as well as information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction, can be obtained from the TxDOT Yoakum District office by calling 361-293-4328.

Any environmental documentation or studies, any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Yoakum District Office, 403 Huck St., Yoakum, TX, 77995. Project materials are also available online at [www.TxDOT.gov](http://www.TxDOT.gov), keyword search: "FM 102 from I-10 to 0.66 miles south of FM 949". These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person public meeting option.

The in-person public meeting and virtual option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation
