This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed Interstate Highway 10 (I-10) roadway project, and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project would reconstruct and widen I-10 from Farm-to-Market (FM) 2434 to United States Highway (US) 90 (Alleyton Road South) in Colorado County, Texas.

The FONSI and approved final environmental assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Yoakum District Office, 403 Huck St, Yoakum, Texas 77995. They are also available online at www.txdot.gov keyword search "I-10 from FM 2434."
