Finding of No Significant Impact Available for Public Review

This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed US 77 project, and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project would widen US 77 from a 2-lane highway to a 4-lane divided highway from SH 71 to approximately 0.56 mile north of CR 156 in Fayette and Lee Counties, Texas.

The FONSI and approved final environmental assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Yoakum District Office, 403 Huck St., Yoakum Tx, 77995 (361-293-4300). They are also available online at www.txdot.gov, Search: US 77 from SH 71.
