I-35 Expansion Project Cooke County

Phase 1: Spring Creek Road to US 82

CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION



Project Overview

The I-35 project from 1.4 miles south of Spring Creek Road to 0.2 miles south of US 82 addresses mobility and safety by widening and realigning I-35 through Gainesville from 4 lanes to 6 lanes. Lack of mobility on I-35 threatens the economic livelihood of Texas. With 65,500 vehicles traveling on this segment of I-35 each day, this project will improve mobility, safety, and connectivity for all modes of transportation along I-35.

Phase 1 extends through 7.3 miles of Cooke County. Work will be conducted six days a week and some nights as needed.

Work includes adding acceleration and deceleration lanes and barrier walls and making drainage improvements to the freeway facility. The project will also change the existing two-way frontage roads to one-way lane frontage roads for Northbound and Southbound to improve safety and increase capacity and add a curb and gutter drainage system to replace the bar ditch system.



Details

This \$209 million project is funded by TxDOT. Construction begins mid-2021 and is expected to be complete in late-2024, weather permitting. The contractor for the project is Austin Bridge & Road and Zachry JV.
