# Reminder on the NEW UAR



The implementation of the new Utility Accommodation Rules (UAR) is entering its third week. The new UAR was effective immediately upon passage of the Rules on all utility related submittals to TxDOT.

A couple of reminders as you are coordinating with utility companies on these changes.

Situation	Action
Utility Agreements signed before October 12, 2022	Previous UAR applies, no changes need to be made.
Utility Agreements which have <u>not</u> been signed and no design plans has been completed prior to October 12, 2022	New UAR applies
Utility Agreements which have <u>not</u> been signed but design plans have been completed prior to October 12, 2022	Coordinate with your supervisor and the maintenance/permit office in your district, then reach out to ROW Division where the situation will be decided on a case by case basis.
Utility installations by permit that are not associated with a transportation project	Contact Maintenance (MNT) Division for guidance.
