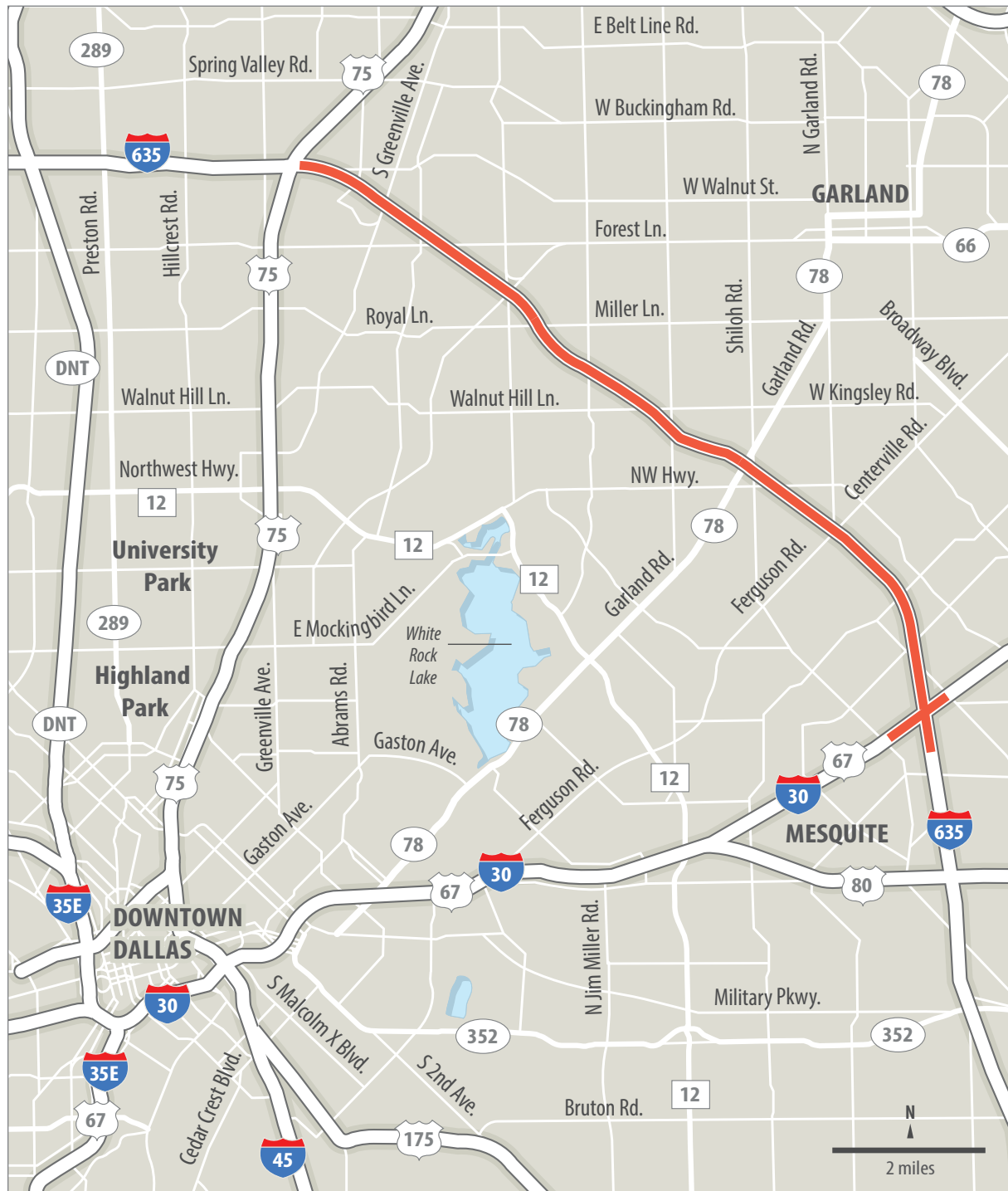


# LBJ EAST 635: DESIGN-BUILD

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The I-635 LBJ East Project will consist of full reconstruction and widening of I-635 from US 75 to I-30, including the I-30 interchange, approximately 11 miles. The general purpose lanes will be widened from 8 to 10 lanes and the existing tolled managed lanes will remain as two lanes.

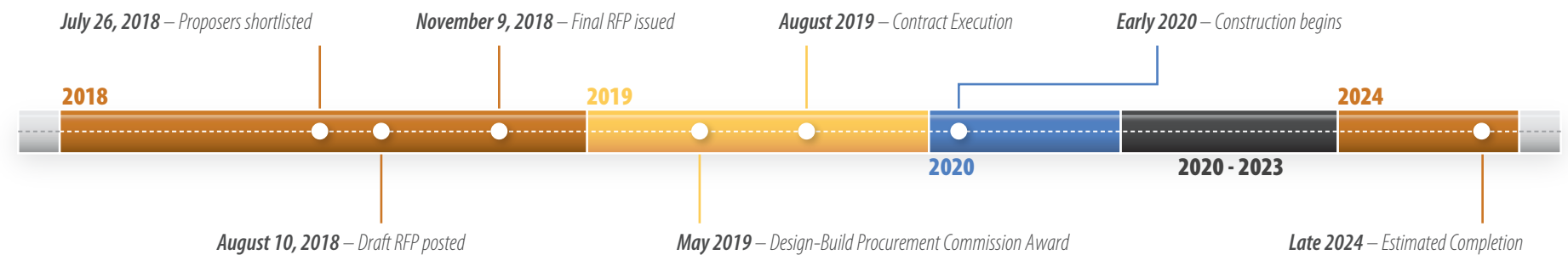
The project also will construct continuous frontage roads and numerous intersection improvements.

## PROJECT STATUS

The project originally received a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) in January 2003. The revised design schematic and environmental re-evaluation were approved in July 2017 and April 2017, respectively.

The \$1.74 billion project was conditionally awarded to Pegasus Link Constructors on May 30, 2019.

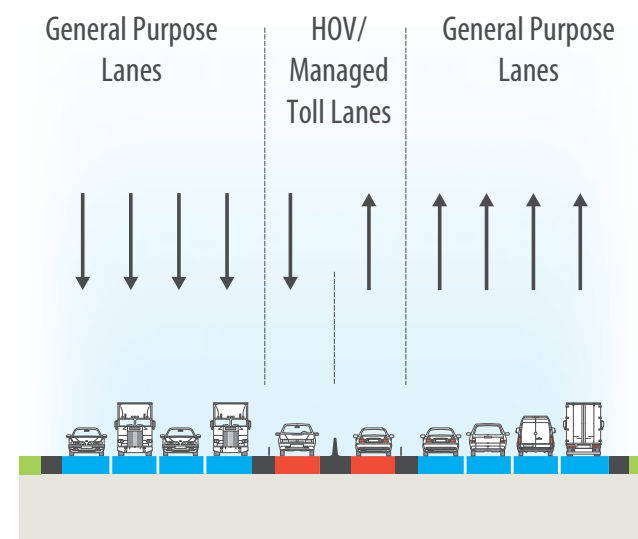
## TIMELINE – DESIGN BUILD PROCUREMENT



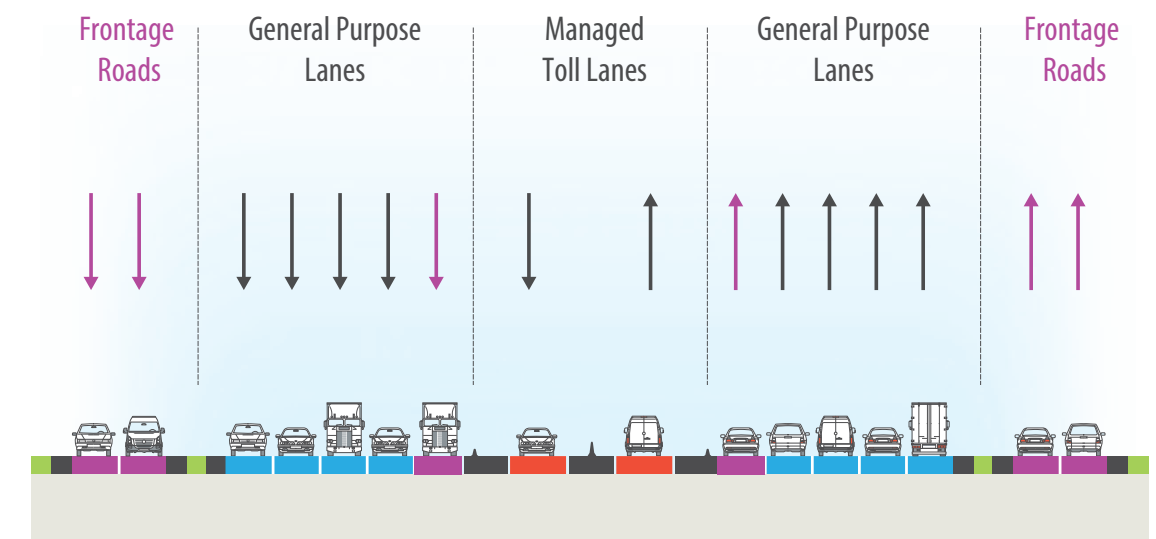
